

HOW TO MAKE AN EFFECTIVE POLICE REPORT:

When you call the Police or Discover Pacific Beach Clean and Safe Program, making an accurate description is critical. Answer the following questions:

1.) DESCRIPTION

What is the person wearing? What color is their clothing? Are they wearing a hat? What color is their hair and skin? Do they have facial hair? How tall are they?

2.) WHAT ARE THEY DOING?

Are they yelling? Are they sitting or standing? Are they walking in a particular direction?

3.) ADDRESS AND CONTACT NUMBER

Be sure to report the nearest address of your location not just the business name. Provide cross streets if possible. Think about these things before you call.

LETTER OF AGENCY:

A letter of agency; or trespass arrest authorization, is required to allow SDPD to ask unauthorized persons to leave your property when you are not there or after business hours. You can find the letter of agency form at www.sandiego.gov or ask one of our safety ambassadors to assist you in applying for one.

The goals of Pacific Beach Clean & Safe are to help unhoused individuals by providing jobs and upward mobility and decrease complaints associated with inappropriate and aggressive behavior

FINDING WORK IN COMMUNITY-FINDING COMMUNITY IN WORK

We are partnering with Pacific Beach Street Guardians to provide added cleaning services to the public right of way. PBSG offers community education to share about life on the streets and to dispel myths, fears and stereotypes of those who experience homelessness; provides transitional employment for unhoused Team Members to earn money and gain experience for future long-term employment; and conducts employment and life-skills training for Team Members to better understand their purpose and callings. If you notice debris or litter in the public right of way, businesses can report it (free of charge).

National Public Safety was founded in 1996 and has provided excellent service to the San Diego community for over 18 years. NPS has a well established 24 Hour Dispatch Center. The dispatch center receives all calls and will dispatch them accordingly. All incoming and outgoing calls are recorded in case of any discrepancies.

HOMELESS OUTREACH

Our Clean and Safe team is equipped to share resources to those in need of services. Here are tips on what you can do to help.

What Helps

1. Donate to local service providers*
2. Donate left over food to local food banks*
3. Volunteer at local service providers *
4. Try effective communication

What Doesn't Help

1. Giving cash handouts on the streets encourages a culture of dependence
2. Giving left over food on the streets.
3. Engaging in arguments, threatening or taking the law into your own hands.
