RHCSD: Marian Novack introduced Jimmy Parker as a consultant on their Designated Driver Program and Jimmy talked about how Pacific Beach would be a great place to test out a Designated Driver program in restaurants, create point of sale buttons and reward and track designated drivers within restaurants.

Sara urged the businesses to support the campaign using #SDPD Proud, posting pictures of how PD is helping our community creating safe environments and hanging flyers in their restaurants.
