CLEAN

In a single day, Discover PB's Clean and Safe Program collects over 1.2 tons of trash (2,592 lbs a day)

Since the start of the program, they have collected over 256 tons of trash from trash cans

Since the start of the program, they have collected nearly 12 tons of litter from streets (23,760 lbs)

Painted and maintained over 30 bike racks in the public right of way Maintained Grand Median landscaping at entry way to PB



HOMELESS OUTREACH

Employed 29 unhoused Pacific Beach residents

5 of which have found permanent housing options and other full time work.

Formally offered over 20 unhoused individuals outreach referral services





Provided 40 hours a week of security ambassadors acting as additional eyes and ears on the street.

Addressed nuisance behaviors including fights, trespassing and littering. Responded to medical calls, mental health issues and shoplifting cases -successfully returning items to retailer. Contacted and educated public on regulations surrounding dockless bikes and scooters Enrolled 28 businesses into Letter of Agency program with SDPD to address trespassing issues.

Since January 1, 2018 PB CLEAN AND SAFE has responded to 544 calls
